## **ALLOCATED DOUBLES COMPETITION**

We plan to run an additional competition this year which we hope will encourage more players outside of the Premier Division to come to the tournament. All players (with the exception of top 8 Men's seeds) will be entered in an allocated doubles competition, where the highest rated player will be paired with a lower rated player, second highest rated player paired with second lowest rated and so on, with a random draw so any pair could win the event! We hope this will be a fun competition and if successful will become a regular feature of the tournament.

## **REFRESHMENTS**

There are no refreshment facilities at the venue apart from vending machines so please bring your own food and drink.

## **PARKING**

There is no parking for competitors at the venue. There is however limited parking on Spring Lane. Competitors can use Canterbury Christ Church University Green Car Park which has 33 and 1 disability spaces and can be accessed by driving off the main road (Longport) heading directly towards the former Prison's very large wooden gates and turning right which is just outside the former prisons wall.

The other car park is off North Holmes road and is the Black Car Park and has 81 spaces which is just outside the former prison's wall. You are able to utilise these car parks free of charge. There are also approx. 80 car parking spaces along North Holmes Road that are free to use at the weekend. These car parks are just over a 5 minute walk from the venue.
